

CONSTITUTION

- 1. The name of the society is Wildsight.
- 2. The purposes of the Society are:
 - a) to promote the maintenance of a healthy, liveable environment for all life;
 - b) to prevent and eliminate pollution;
 - c) to promote conservation;
 - d) to assist others in the pursuit of environmental conservation;
 - e) to investigate, study and correlate facts with respect to ecological and pollution problems and make available such studies to the general public;
 - f) to develop strategies for the long term viability of our community in harmony with above purposes.
- 3. The operations of the Society shall be carried on without purpose of gain for its members and any profits or other accretions to the Society shall be used in promoting the purposes of the Society.
- 4. In the event of the winding up or dissolution of the Society, any funds and assets of the Society remaining after the satisfaction of its debts and liabilities, shall be given or transferred to such organizations concerned with environmental conservation problems or organizations promoting the same objectives of this Society, as may be determined by the members of the Society at the time of winding up or dissolution. In the event that the foregoing provisions cannot be effected, then such funds shall be given or transferred to some other organizations, provided that such organizations referred to in this article shall be a charitable organization, a charitable corporation, or a charitable trust recognized by the Department of National Revenue of Canada as being qualified as such under the provisions of the Income Tax Act of Canada from time to time in effect.
- 5. Articles 3 and 4 of this constitution and this article are unalterable in accordance with section 22 of the Societies Act. Articles 1 and 2 are alterable in accordance with the Societies Act and the by-laws.
