Harvest & Access Expectations



Harvesting local trees is a great way to collect nutritious food while reducing wildlife attractants!

What are the expectations when you harvest?

🍏 Please make sure you contact the tree owner before you harvest registered tree ; please confirm both the day and time you plan to access the property

🍏 Please check the [Fruit Tree Registration Tree Board](#) for tree owner requests such as owner requests for a portion of the fruit, disposal location of spoiled fruit/windfall, and where and how to access the property.

🍏 Please be mindful while harvesting; broken branches and stripped leaves may result in owner no longer allowing access to the trees

🍏 Parents/guardians are responsible for the safety of their children; helmets are recommended to protect from falling apples

🍏 You are not expected to harvest all the fruit/apples on the trees; collect whatever fruit you feel comfortable reaching/accessing

🍏 [You are responsible for your own safety.](#) Do not enter a property that appears dangerous or unsafe. Tree owners are required to ensure their dogs are restrained from entering the area during the arrangement picking time.

🍏 Tree owners may request that spoil fruit/windfall is raked up and placed in a specific location but ultimately up tree owners take the appropriate measures to care for their trees.

Helpful Items to Bring to the Pick:

- Ladder (Available through our [Tool Share Program](#))
- Gloves
- Fruit boxes for your share of fruit (cardboard boxes, ice cream buckets, pails, plastic or cloth bags)
- Rake (for cleanup of windfall/damaged fruit)
- Fruit Picker (Available through our [Tool Share Program](#))
