Toad Watch Guidelines: Stay safe and #stopthesquish

Toad Watch Safety Protocols

- No toading alone - always go Toad Watching with a buddy or group. In order to participate, you must receive training from a Wildsight staff member or have attended the Williamson Lake Training Day event.
 - Check in with the Toad Watch Coordinator at the start and end of your shift to let them know when you are finished and headed home.
 - All participants must sign liability waivers.

- Wear PPE. Wildsight provides reflective vests to Toad Watch volunteers.
 - Dress for the weather, bring layers and rain gear for variable conditions.
 - Bring a headlamp and bear spray.
 - Wear clean gloves when handling toads.
 - Stay low to the ground when moving toads in case they wiggle and escape.
 - Do not harass any wildlife. Anyone caught doing this will be banned from participation.
 - Keep off the road as much as possible to respect motorists and cyclists.
 - Remove deceased toads from the road to prevent further wildlife mortalities as scavengers may be attracted to the free toad buffet.
