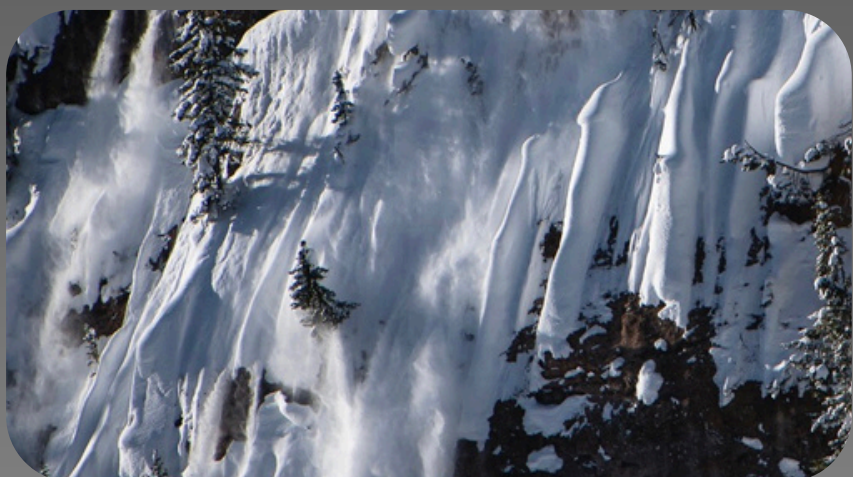
TRAIL TO BAYANIHAN
